OPEN HOUSE

ADMISSIONS/ SCHOLARSHIP TEST

All students requesting admission to the 9th grade must take the admission scholarship test at the school. In order to take the test, students must have a completed application on file in the Admission Office by November 13th. Students must bring two #2 pencils at the time of the test. The test lasts three hours.

REGISTRATION

Conditional registration will be on-going from Open House (October 25th). Registration will be completed once the Admission Office has reviewed the admission test scores and the 7th and 8th grade marks. The registration fee is \$125 (non-refundable). If you register by January 31st the fee will be \$100, after that date \$125, payable by check, money order, or cash.

Directions to West Catholic

FROM SOUTH PHILADELPHIA

- Broad Street Subway North to City Hall. Market/ Frankford EL (B Trains Only) West to 46th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.
- Any bus or trolley route North to Walnut Street (#7, 17, 2, 23, 47). West on Walnut Street on Route 21 Bus to 45th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.

FROM SOUTHWEST PHILADELPHIA

- Special SEPTA charter buses run along #411, 415, and 418 via Elmwood Avenue, Passyunk Avenue, 72nd Street, Dicks Avenue, 62nd Street, Woodland Avenue, 54th Street, Greenway Avenue, 49th Street, Baltimore Avenue, and Chestnut Street.

FROM WEST PHILADELPHIA

- Special SEPTA charter buses run along #410 Bus route via 76th Street, Overbrook Avenue, Haverford Avenue, Lansdowne Avenue, 63rd Street, and Chestnut Street.
- Market. Frankford EL (B Trains Only) to 46th Street.

FROM NORTH/ NORTHEAST PHILADELPHIA

- Broad Street Subway South to City Hall. Market / Frankford EL (B Trains Only) West to 46th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.
- Any bus or trolley route to Broad Street Subway (56, 60, 54, 39, 3, 15, 43). Broad Street Subway South to City Hall. Market/ Frankford EL (B Trains only) West to 46th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.
- Any bus or trolley route to Market/ Frankford EL (#57, 39, 5, 25, 54, 60, 56, 66, 89, J, 73). Market/ 69th Street EL (B Trains only) to 46th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.
- R7 train to 30th Street. Market/ Frankford EL (B trains Only) to 46th Street. Walk 1 block to West Catholic.

FROM DELAWARE COUNTY

- Transportation is subsidized by the local public school district.

FROM NEW JERSEY

- High Speed Line across Ben Franklin Bridge to Center City. Market/ Frankford EL (B Trains only) West to 46th Street. Walk 1 Block to West Catholic.
